

MIDLAND COUNTY CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES For 2022 - 2023

Each year, the Midland County Educational Service Agency in partnership with Bullock Creek School District, Coleman Community Schools, Meridian Public Schools, Midland Public Schools and Windover High School, offers Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs at various sites throughout Midland County. All of these programs are open to students from any Midland County School with transportation available. These programs are designed to prepare youth for a broad range of employment and advanced training/educational opportunities and are offered under the guidance of certified instructors, counselors, and administrators.

The following CTE programs are available to high school students in Midland County for the 2022-2023 school year:

Automotive Technology	11 th or 12 th grade students (selectively open to 10 th grade) with career interests in automotive technology and mechanics. Program follows National Automotive Curriculum standards (NATEF).	Midland Public Schools
Biomedical Sciences	11 th or 12 th grade students (selectively open to 10 th grade) with career interests in biomedical sciences.	Meridian Public Schools
Building Construction Trades	11 th or 12 th grade students(selectively open to 10 th grade) With career interests in various construction trades such as carpentry, electrical and plumbing. Focus on residential construction with students building a house.	Bullock Creek Midland Public Schools
Business Administration, Management & Operations	11 th or 12 th grade students (selectively open to 10 th grade) with interest in careers related to business. Focus given to learning all Microsoft Office applications.	Midland Public Schools
Chemical Processing Technology	12 th grade – dual enrollment program at Delta College Interest in a career as a Chemical Process Operator. Completion of Algebra 2 AND completion or concurrent enrollment in Physics required.	Midland County ESA Program held at Delta College
Engineering Technology	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) Career interest in design or engineering.	Meridian Public Schools Midland Public Schools
Culinary Arts	11 th or 12 th grade students (selectively open to 10 th grade) with career interests in hospitality services. Program covers various culinary disciplines.	Windover
Educational Careers	11 th or 12 th grade Interested in working with children within the education system. Includes classroom placement.	Bullock Creek
Healthcare Technology	11 th or 12 th grade with an Interest in healthcare related careers. Ability to complete clinical experience which includes completion of a background check and various health requirements.	Midland Public Schools
Marketing, Sales & Service, and Entrepreneurship	11 th or 12 th grade (selectively open to 10 th grade) with a career interest in marketing, sales or entrepreneurship.	Midland Public Schools
Skilled Trades	11 th or 12 th grade with an interest in Skilled Trades. Program based on National Center for Construction Education and Research Curriculum. Programs offered, Electrical, Plumbing, Welding, Carpentry	Midland County ESA Program Held at Greater Michigan Construction Academy
Welding Technology	11 th or 12 th grade students (selectively open to 10 th grade) interested in welding as a career. Program gives focus to American Welding Society standards.	Midland Public Schools Bullock Creek Schools

Woodworking	11 th or 12 th grade students (selectively open to 10 th grade) With career interests in various woodworking trades such as carpentry, furniture and cabinet making. Program focuses on planning, designing and executing projects in the wood shop.	Bullock Creek Schools
