

MIDLAND COUNTY CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES FOR 2024-2025

Each year, the Midland County ESA's ConneCTEd department, in partnership with Bullock Creek School District, Coleman Community Schools, Meridian Public Schools and Midland Public Schools offers Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs at various sites throughout Midland County. All of these programs are open to students from any Midland County school. These hands-on, experiential, advanced training educational opportunities are offered under the guidance of certified instructors, counselors, and administrators, allowing students to gain skills that can be applied in an industry setting following graduation. Free transportation and high school credits are available for all programs and select programs offer articulated college credit and/or industry certifications.
